

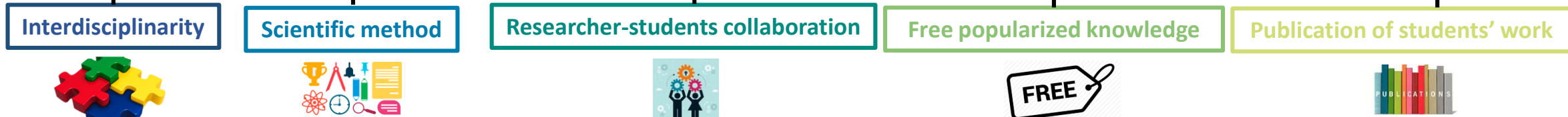

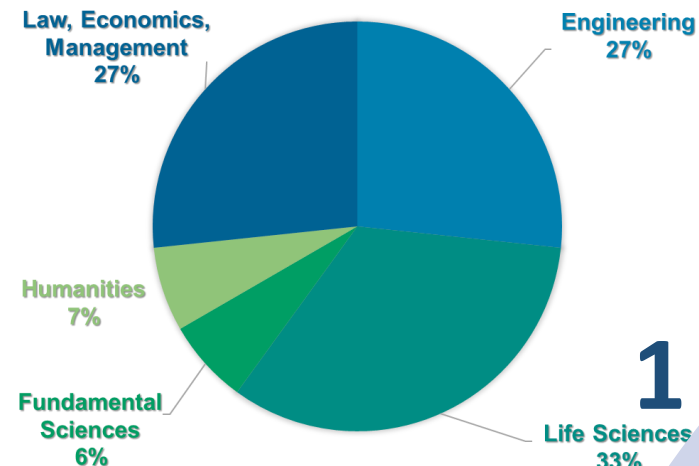

1 A Researcher proposes an abstract to popularize one of their article

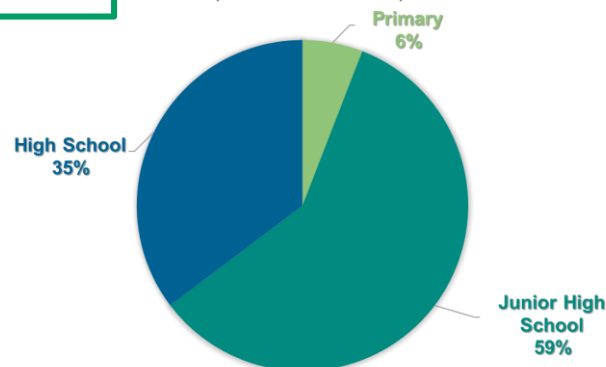
2 A teacher chooses the abstract from the catalog*
