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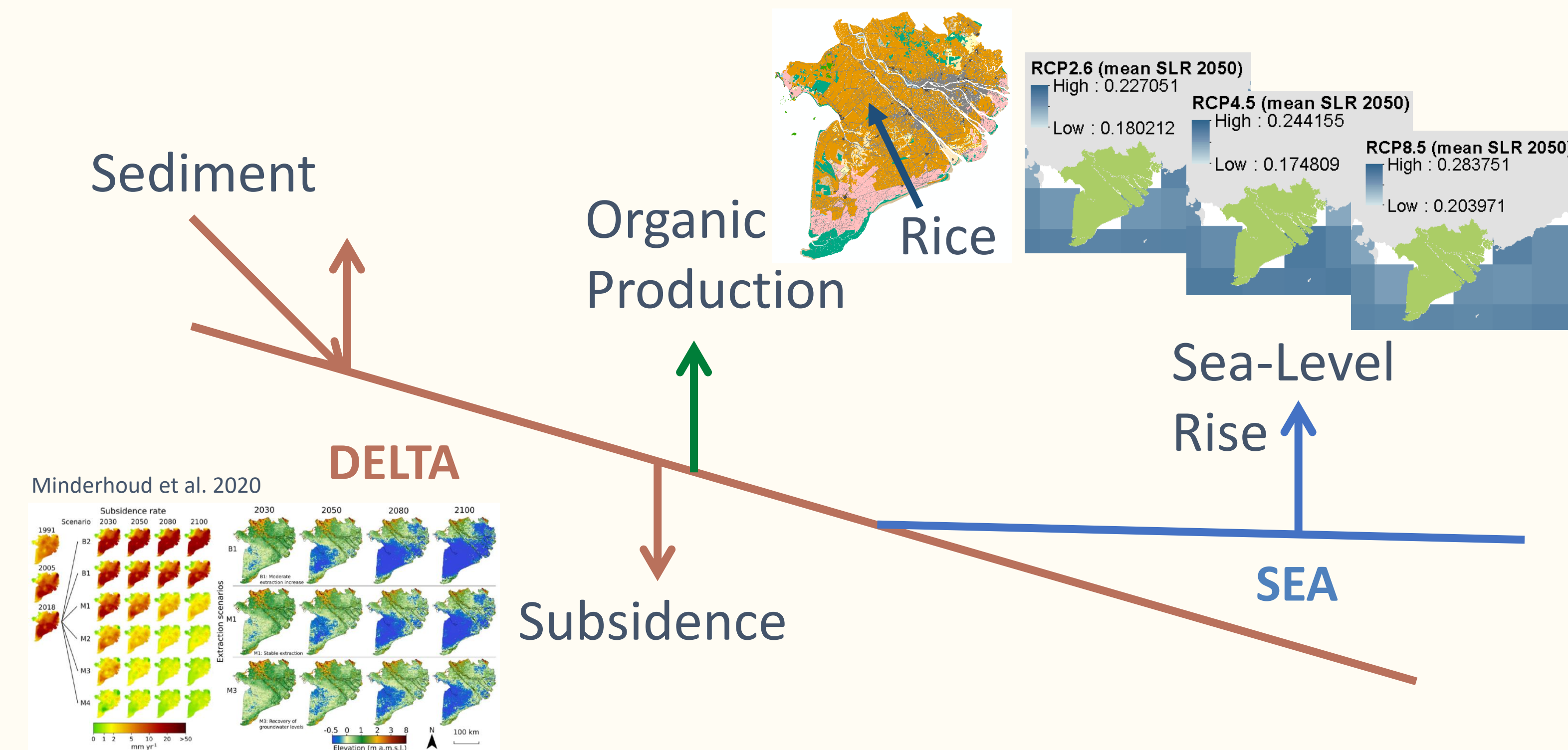


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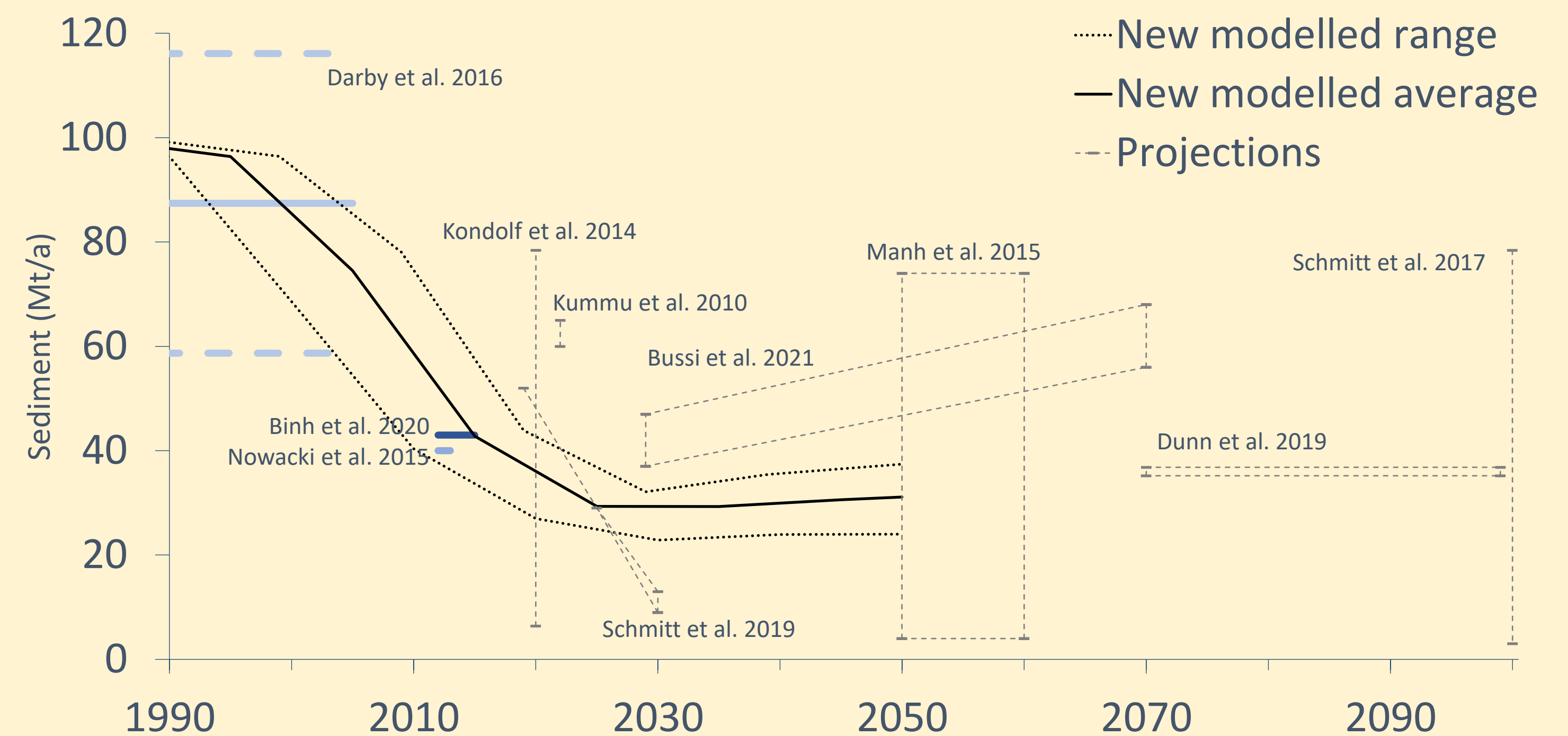
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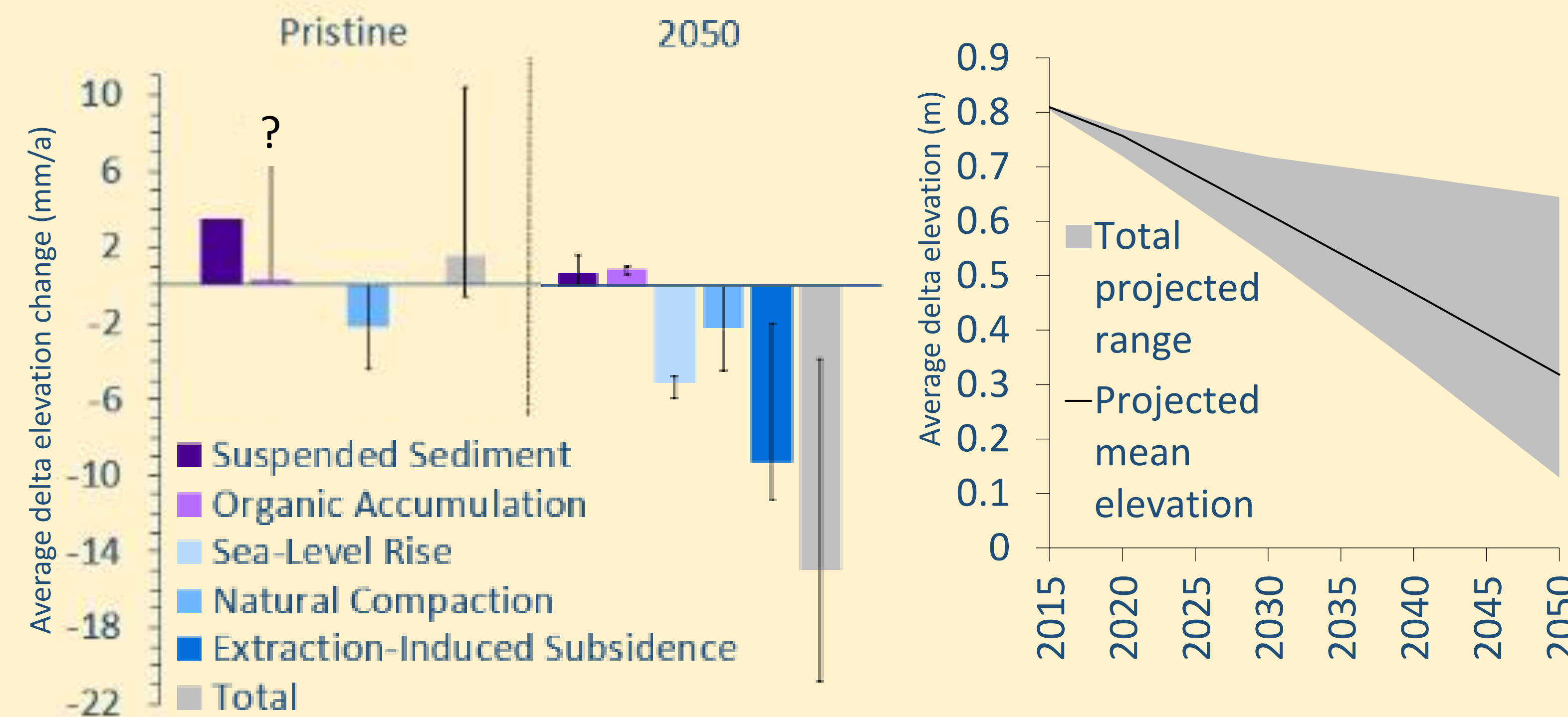
## Drivers of relative sea-level rise in deltas



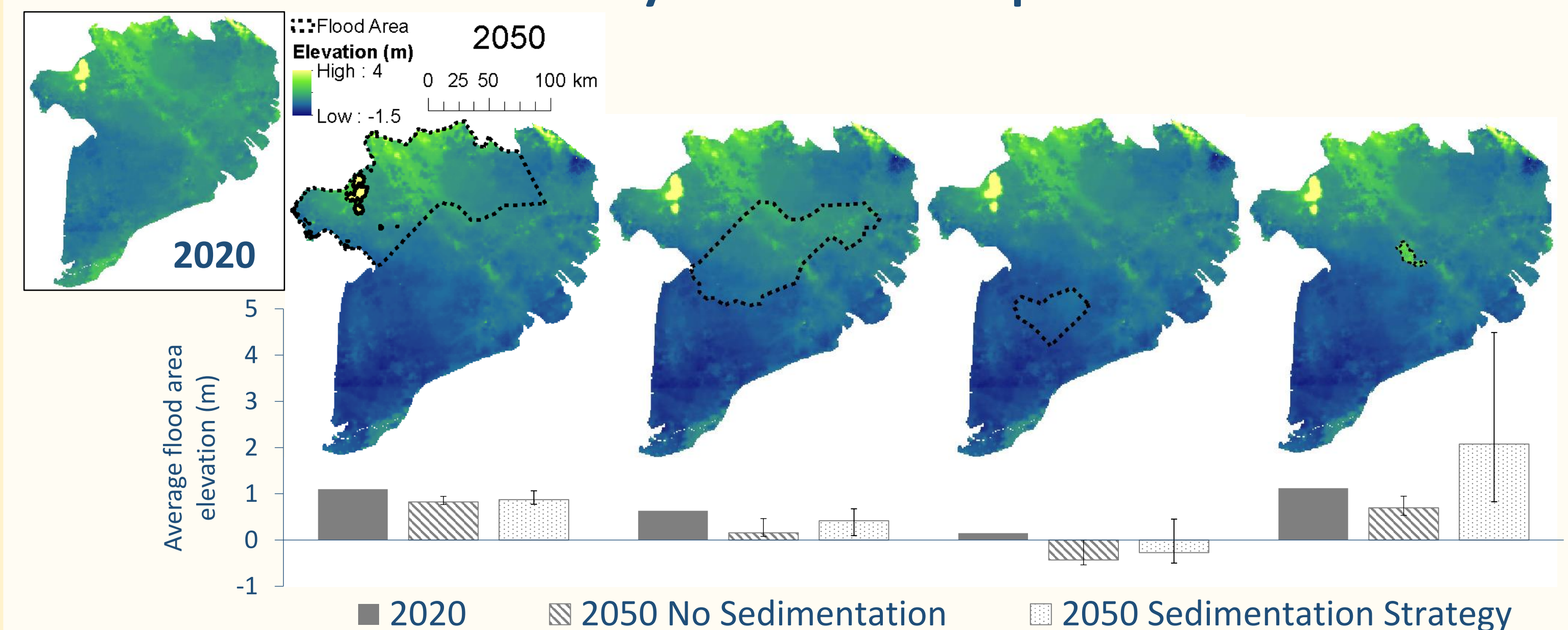
## Declining Mekong sediment loads
