My example

Verner Suomi brings satellite meteorology onto geostationary orbit. The Spin Scan Cloud Camera onboard ATS-1 satellite can observe weather processes with 23-minute resolution. The imagery from “GEOs” is now widely used for weather forecasts or to monitor climate (cloud properties, Earth’s energy budget...).
