## Gender, geographical distribution, career stage

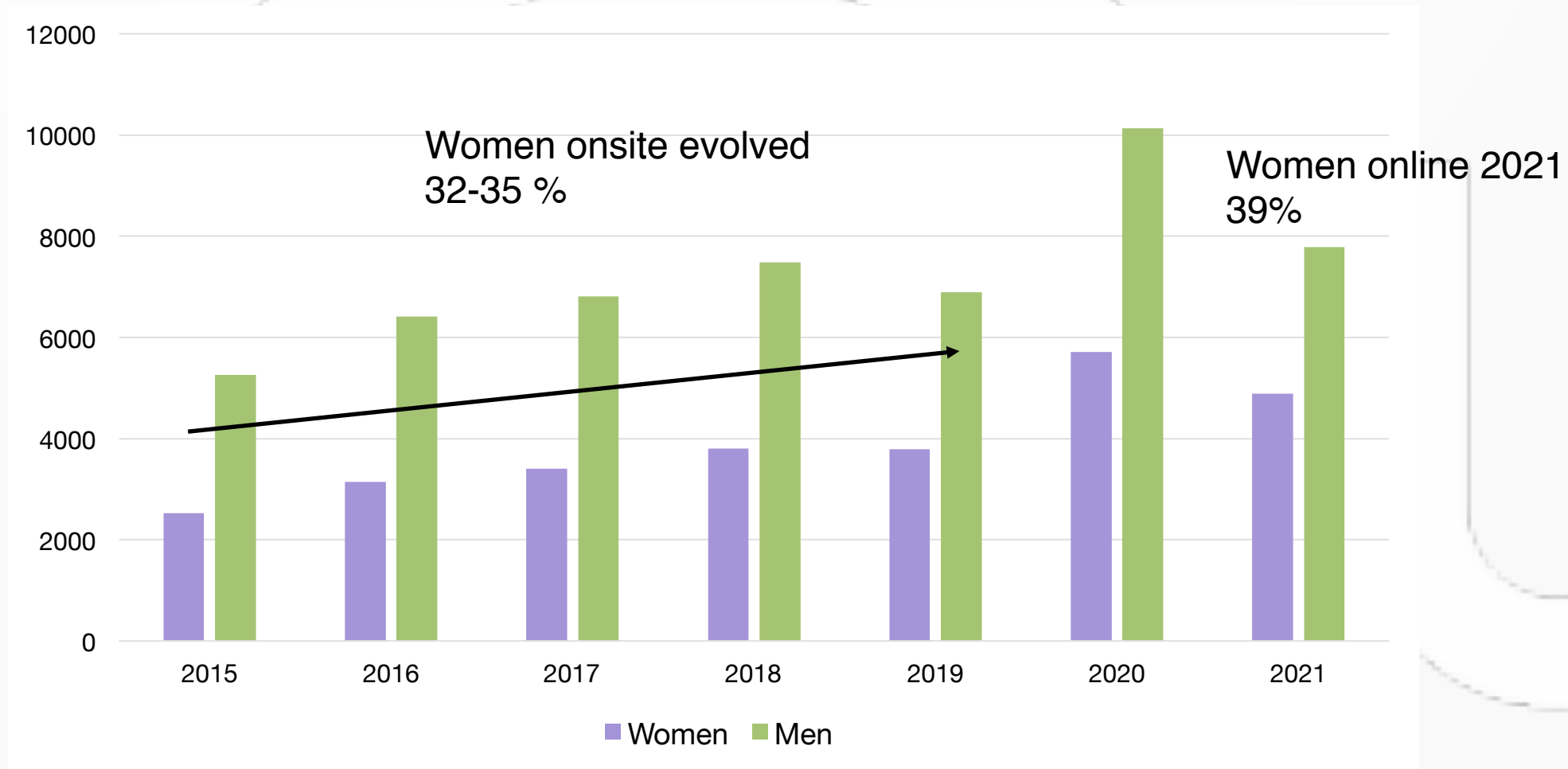
Conferences 2015-2019 in person, 2020 free online (went online after abstract submission), 2021 online with fee (planned to be online)

Data on all who presented and convened at the General Assemblies (GA) 2015-2021 was collected by Copernicus

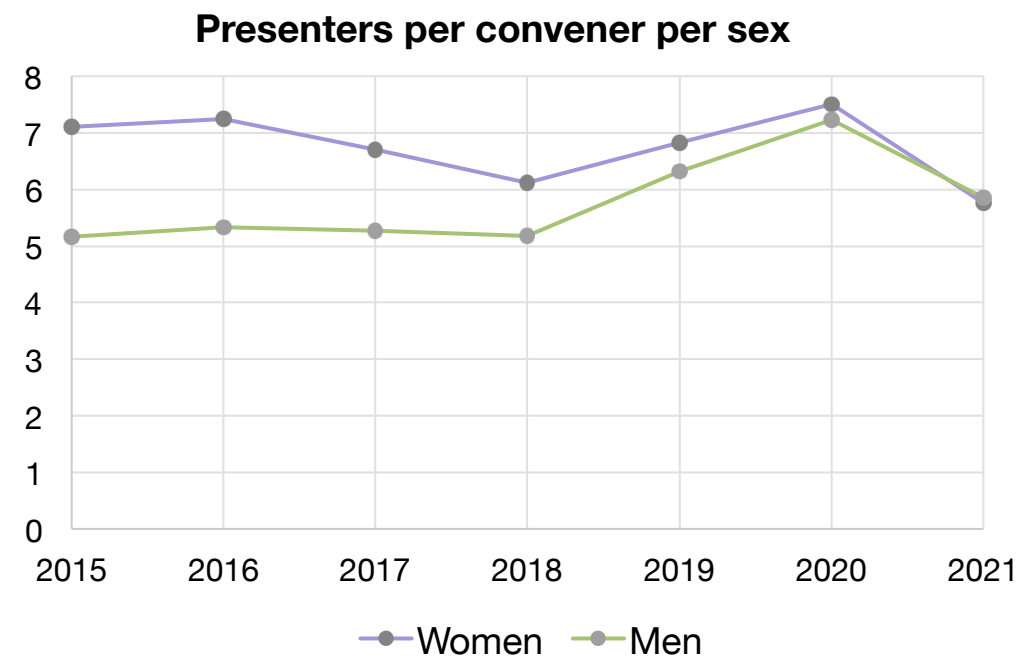
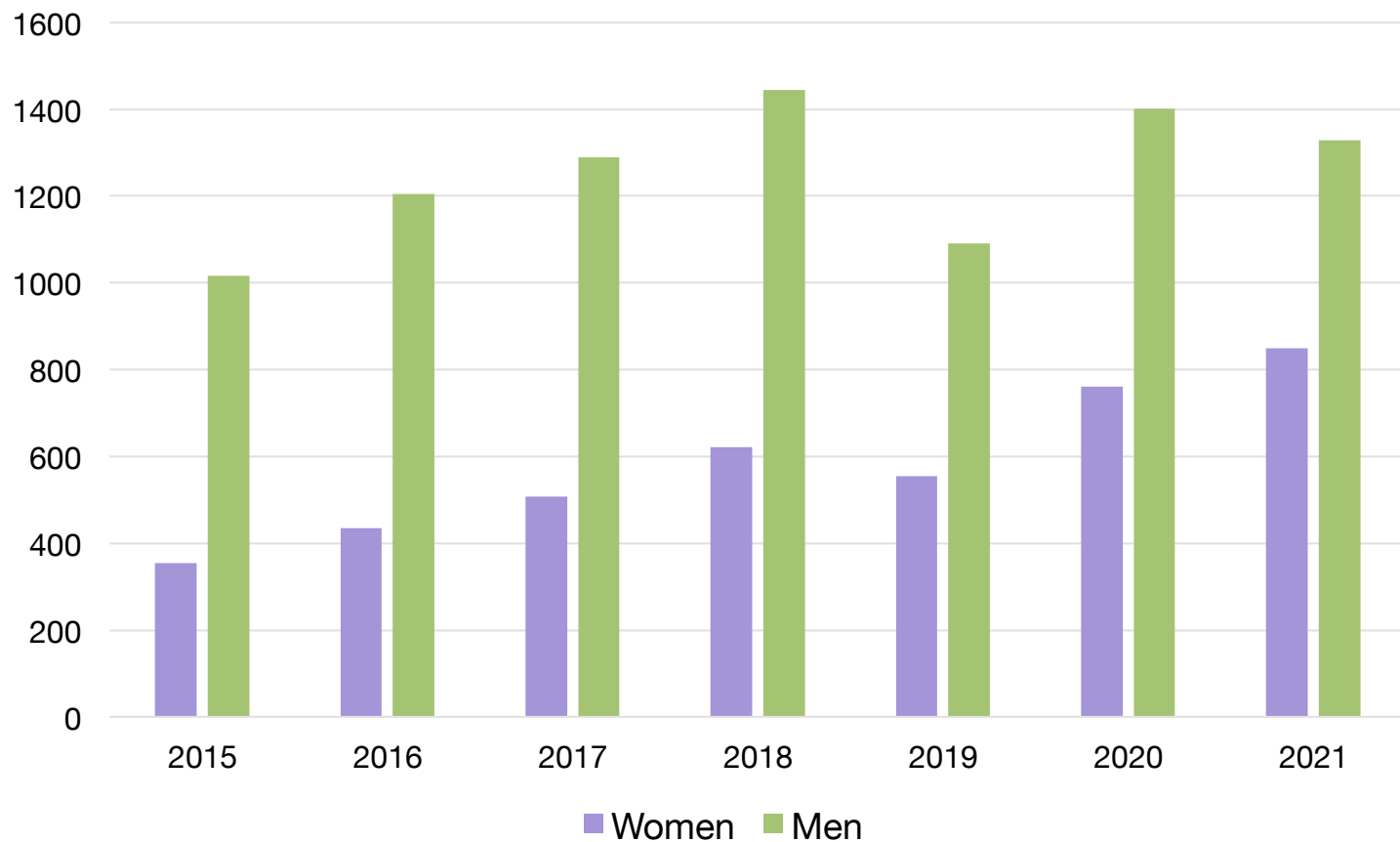

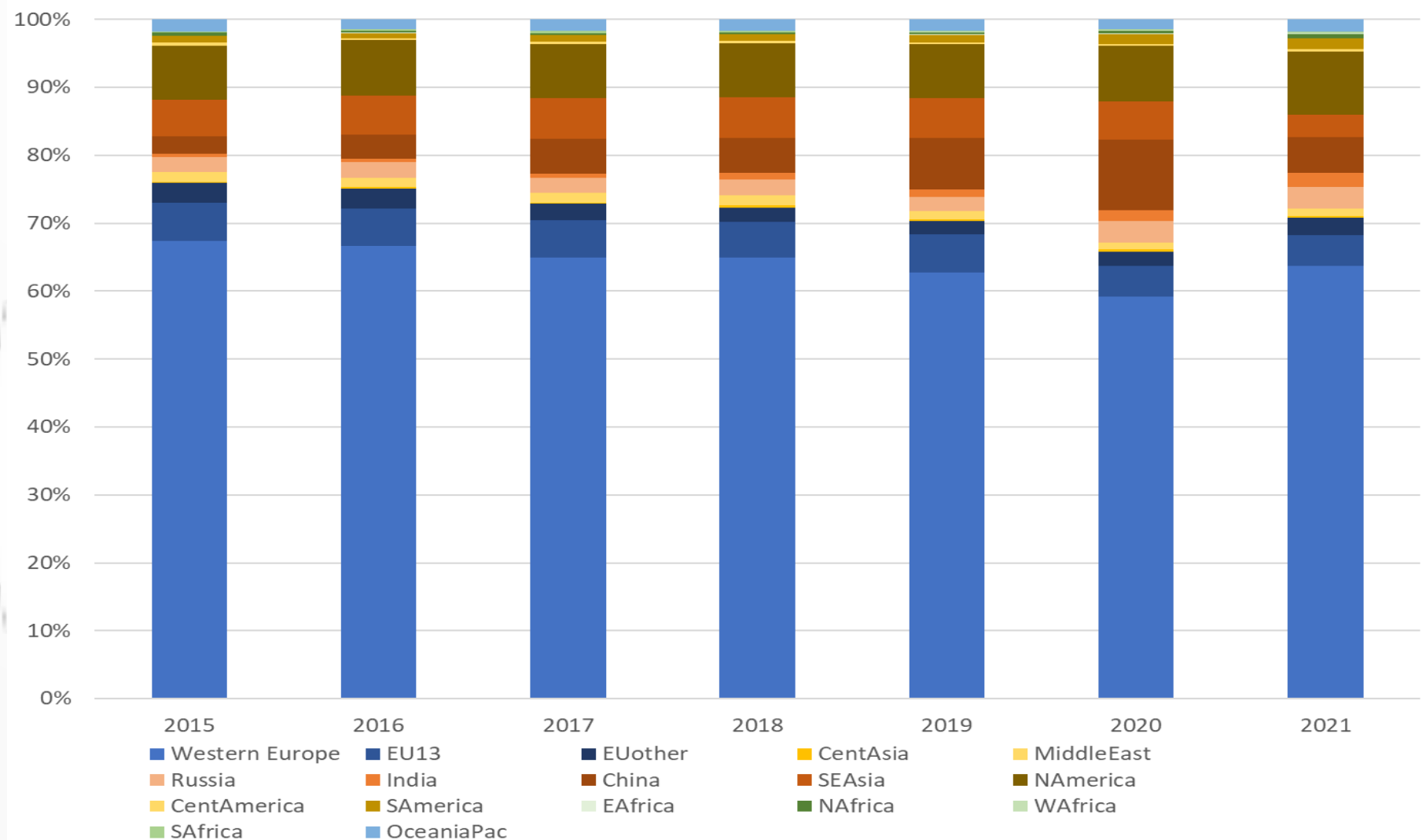
## Gender – presenters



# Gender - conveners



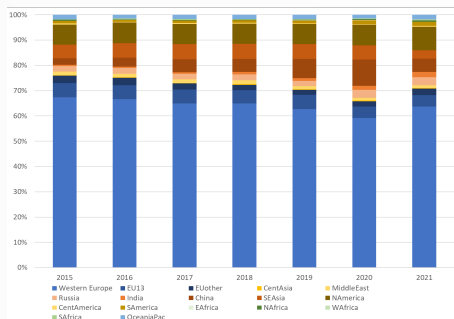
## Geographical distribution - presenters



A majority of the presenters are from western Europe.



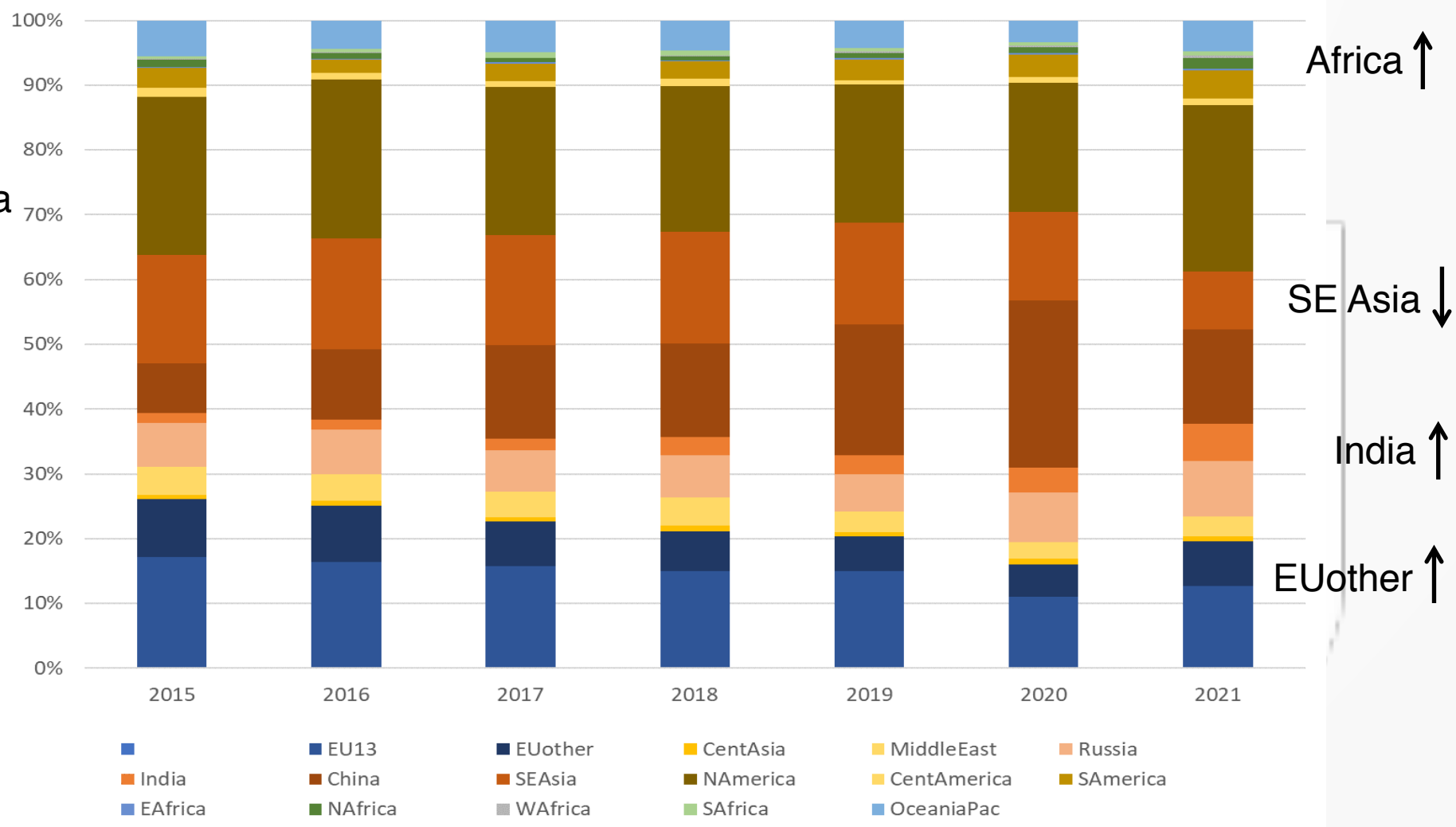
# Geographical distribution - presenters



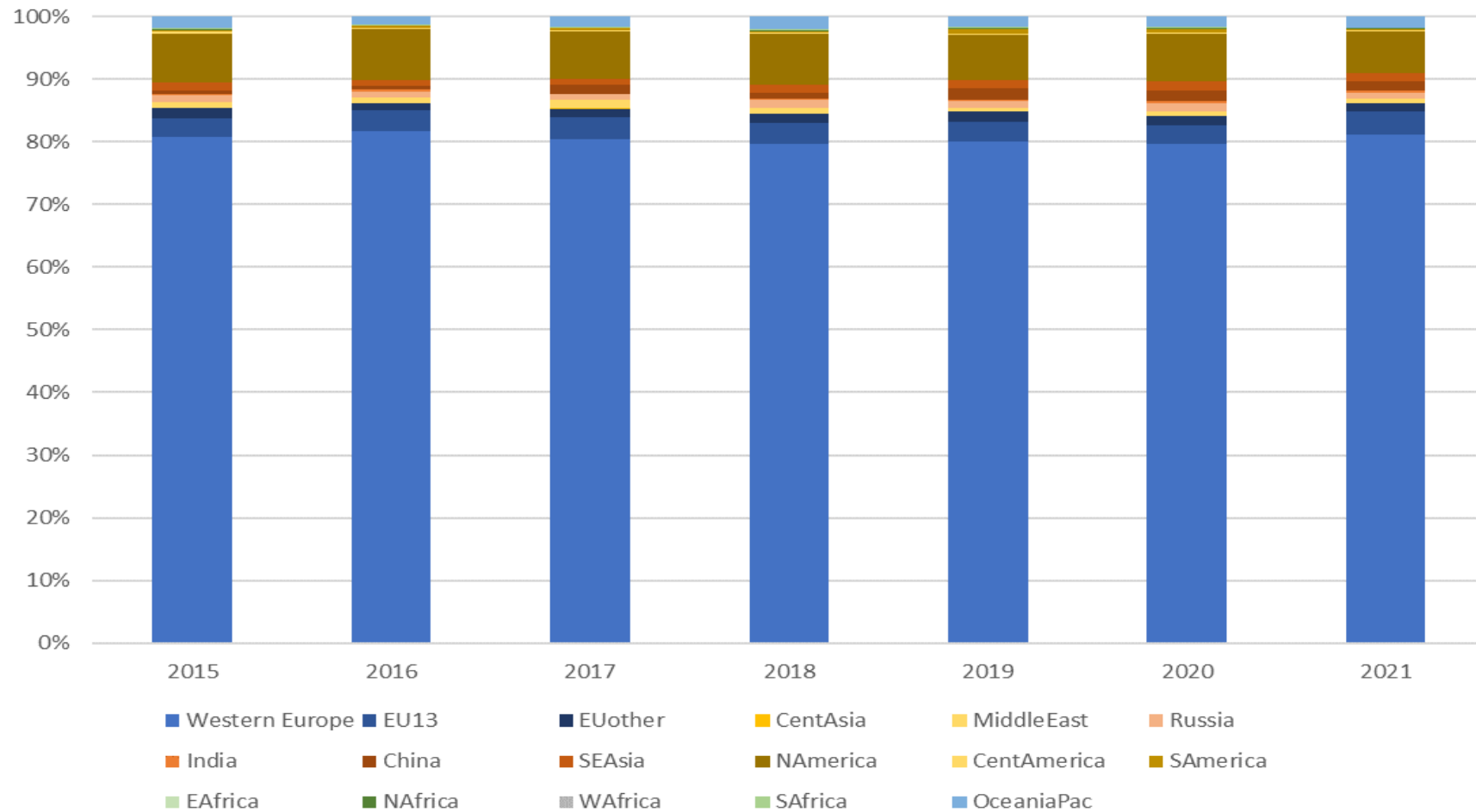

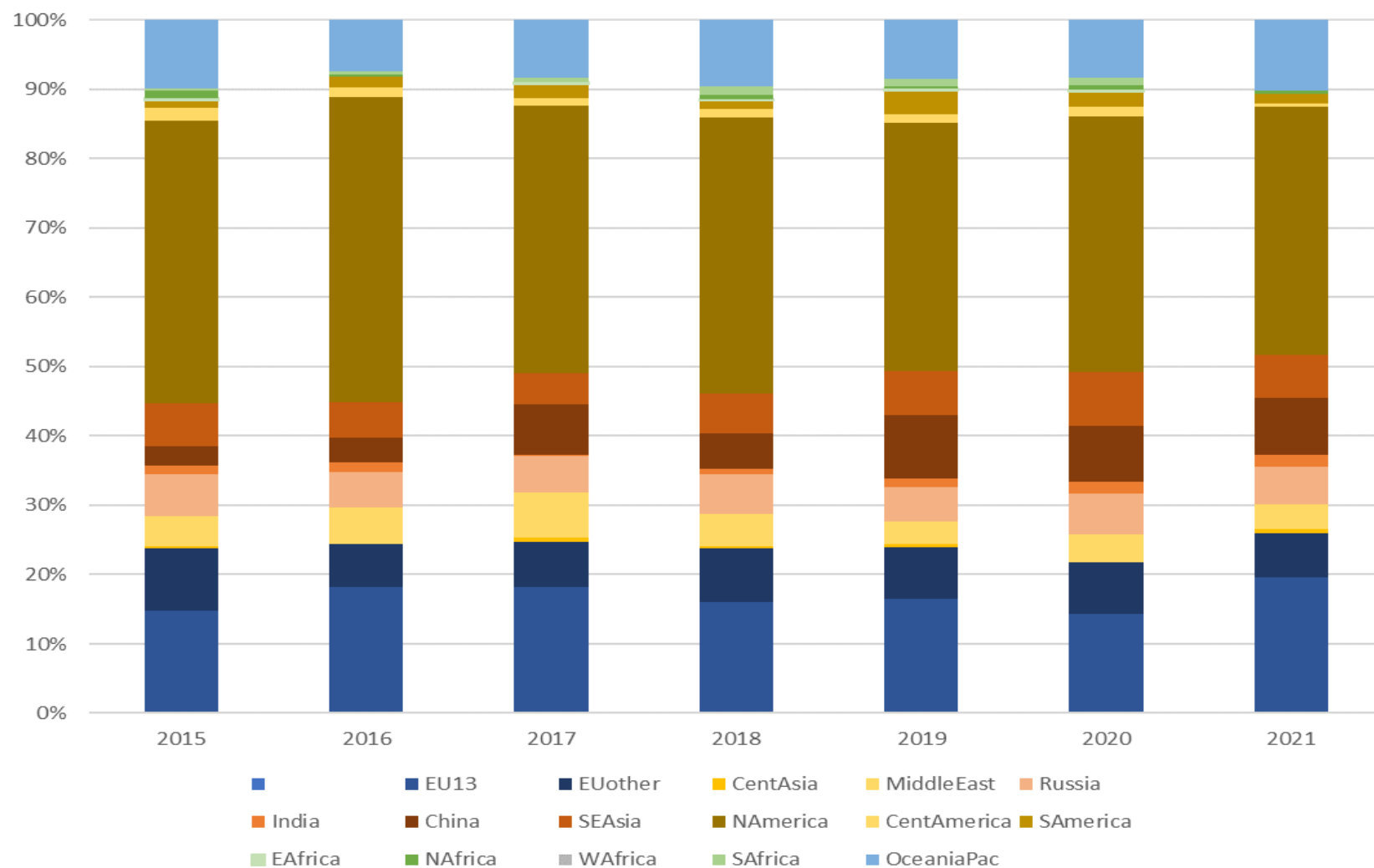
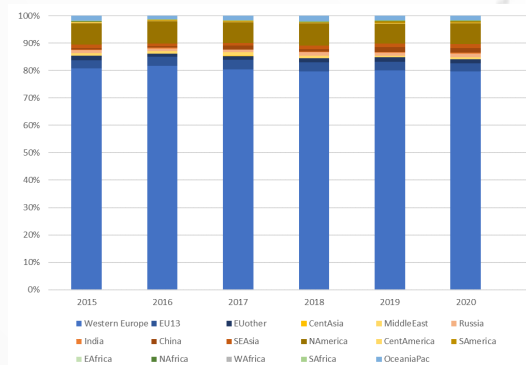


## Geographical distribution - conveners

On average 17% of the presenters were conveners, large differences between regions.



## Conclusions so far

The online and free conferences were to some extent most diverse.

Increased proportion of women presenters and conveners over time, particular increase in the online conference 2021.

Most presenters and conveners are from the western parts of Europe, rather constant over time. Large differences in the presenter/convener ratio between regions.
