

Tuesday

SESSION 1: Co-production: Leading the way in climate services

This session focuses on the co-production approach followed in MED-GOLD and the importance of finding common ground with users, understanding their needs and building trust.

SESSION 2: Towards useful and usable climate services

This session focuses on the technical aspects of the co-development process of climate services and delivering useful and usable information, as well as on evaluating the value brought to users.

SESSION 3: Discover how to apply the MED-GOLD tools in your sector: "Ask us anything"

Four parallel sessions will focus on a different food system covered in MED-GOLD. The MED-GOLD climate services tools will be briefly showcased, and the audience is then encouraged to engage in an interactive discussion with the speakers.

SESSION 1: Adopting and using innovation tools in organisations

This session focuses on the underlying conditions required to adopt and use innovation tools such as those developed in the MED-GOLD project within organisations across Europe.

SESSION 2: Talking Climate for Policymaking

This session focuses on the climate and policies nexus for enlightening cross beneficial needs, success stories and best practices in supporting adaptation and green transition action.

SESSION 3: The legacy of MED-GOLD: the European landscape and beyond

This session addresses the European landscape and the future prospects of MED-GOLD legacy, with focusing on the specific challenges of climate change in the industry of the wine sector.

The two-day event provided an insight into the lessons learned during the project. MED-GOLD users from the agriculture sector, representing the grapes, olives and durum wheat crops – the Portuguese wine company **SOGRAPE**, the Spanish cooperative **Dcoop**, and the Italian food company **Barilla** – presented their success stories as early adopters of the MED-GOLD climate services.

The users also stressed the importance of a co-production approach in creating useful and usable tools for the agriculture sector.

Attendees also had the chance to engage in discussions with the presenters and other project participants, as well as to visit the virtual stands and view the posters, videos, and other materials produced by the MED-GOLD team

A number of panel discussions were organised with representatives from key organisations in the EU food systems, policy organisations and European and international initiatives
