
GEFO PROGRAMME IN ITALY: 5-YEARS ACTIVITIES ACROSS THE COUNTRY

- One of authors (G. Realdon) was appointed and trained as GEFO for Italy in 2019
- T. Gravina was also involved within the EGU Education Committee
- With the support of the UNICAMearth group of the University of Camerino, she started the translation into Italian of the protocols of workshop activities (almost 100 available at present)
- In 2029-2024 she ran 37 workshops with 562 participants in 12 regions spanning the whole country
- Other GEFO's activities in Italy included webinars and presentations at teachers conferences
- Research papers and teaching articles documented and disseminated GEFOs' activities




Workshop locations
