Introduction

Initiative dedicated to promoting gender equality, sustainability and inclusivity across the global aquaculture industry.

- Created in October 2023 and legally established in October 2024.
- Initiatives focusing on providing training, resources, support and empowerment in the women in the aquaculture industry.

Background

- NOWA's journey began in June 2023 during a training session in Athens, facilitated by the GFCM (FAO), the FEAP and HAPO.
- Participants recognized a significant gap in the industry: the need for a dedicated network to support and empower women in aquaculture.
- Four training participants representing the diverse sectors of aquaculture and fisheries across the Mediterranean and Black Sea regions, constituted the founding team of NOWA.



The association advocates for gender equality, sustainable aquaculture practices, and the importance of women's leadership in the industry.

Capacity Building Initiatives

Training courses designed to enhance technical skills and industry knowledge. These include both inperson workshops and online courses to accommodate different learning preferences and schedules.

Promotion of women in aquaculture

Actively promoting women's leadership through testimonials, features, and success stories, enhancing visibility and inspiring other women to join the industry.

Actions

Mentoring Program

NOWA connects emerging profesionals with established leaders in the industry through tailored mentorship programs. These relationships foster profesional growth, provide guidance, and offer strategic career insights.

Career boosting activities

Supporting career advancement through job fairs, a dedicated job board and direct introduction to key industry players, helping members to secure prominent roles and ascend to decision-making positions.

Networking opportunities

Organization of regular networking events, both online and at major industry conferences, enabling members to connect, share experiences, and explore collaborative opportunities.

Advocacy and lobbying for gender equality

NOWA champions gender equality in aquaculture by lobbying advisory boards and associations, ensuring women's roles are recognized and included in industry policies.
